












Community Emergency Response Team

The Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) Program educates people about disaster preparedness for hazards that may impact their area and trains them in basic disaster response skills, such as fire safety, light search and rescue, team organization, and disaster medical operations. Using the training learned in the classroom and during exercises, you will be able to assist others in your neighborhood or workplace following an event when professional responders are not immediately available to help.

The course includes 8 units completed within 4 weeks.
